

Proposed Amendment to the By-Laws regarding Standing Committee Appointments

BY-LAWS OF AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF PHYSICISTS IN MEDICINE (Adopted at Annual Business Meeting, Chicago, Illinois, December 2, 1965)

ARTICLE III: COMMITTEES

Section 1. Appointments and Tenure

The President, with the concurrence of the Board, shall appoint members to the Standing Committees except as provided for in these By-Laws and in accordance with the Rules. [The Councils, as defined in Article III, Section 2, with the concurrence of the Board, shall appoint members to their subordinate Standing Committees.](#)

Justification:

The Board of Directors directed the Rules Committee to specify in the AAPM Rules that “the President shall appoint members of standing committees, except for categorical council committees. “

The Rules Committee found it desirable to propose amendments to the By-Laws, Article III, Section 1, to clarify the intent to make the Councils responsible for appointments to subordinate standing committees.
