Dear Resident:

To protect vulnerable populations from concerns related to the COVID-19 pandemic, many hospitals and clinics are curtailing or converting non-essential activities, including educational activities, to minimize transmission of the virus. These changes may impact the timely completion of clinical milestones for medical physics residents, or at worse, result in delays in the completion of their residency training. Future travel restrictions may affect the ability of senior residents from interviewing for permanent positions.

AAPM is monitoring the situation and has been working closely with CAMPEP and SDAMPP to communicate with stakeholders. In view of these extenuating circumstances, we would encourage you to:

- Review and discuss your institutional policy for sick leave with your residency director.
 - Review and discuss your institutional policy for remediation with your residency director.
- Details should be contained in section 8.3 of the programs CAMPEP self-study.
