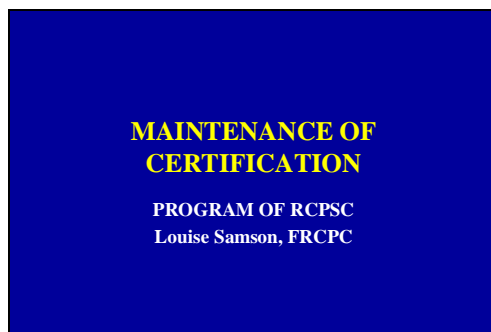
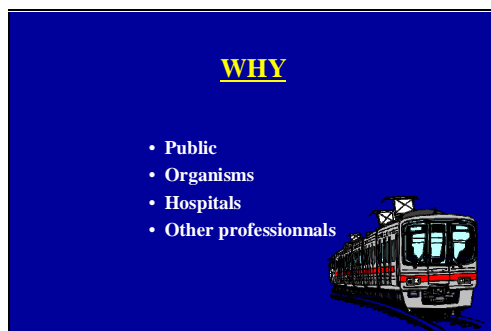


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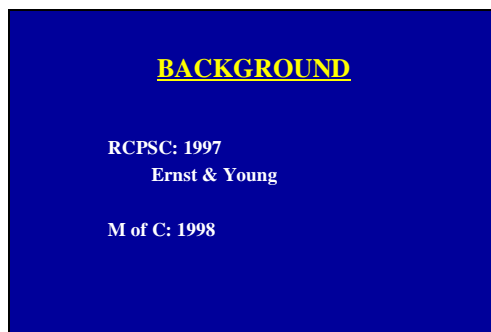

GENERAL PRINCIPLES

Mandatory to maintain FRCPC(S)
5 years cycle, 2001-2006
400 credits/5y (\Rightarrow 80/y)
Minimum 40 c/y
Credits summary to be sent by
December 31st (January 31st LIMIT)
Public register
3% validation (once in your career)

1 Accredited Group Learning Activities

- Education sessions produced by accredited providers of CPD activities eg annual meetings of many NSS
 - Rounds, journal clubs can be accredited
 - Workshops, courses, conferences (NSS, Faculty Office of CME)
 - Annual meetings (RSNA-ARRS)
 - 1 credit/hr - no maximum
- * Should be written on the program that the activity is accredited

Accreditation of rounds, journal clubs, etc

- Planning committee
- Needs assessment
- Plan and advertise programme
- Time for discussion (25%)
- Evaluation of programme and sessions
- Record of attendance

2 Other learning activities

- Learning activities not sponsored by an accredited provider
- Non-accredited rounds & meetings
- Reading (browsing) journals and texts, audio/videotapes
- Information (e.g., Medline) searches
 - without keeping records or linking to patient problem
- Computer/Internet CME
- 1 credit/hr, maximum 100 credits/5 yr (or 20c/y)

3 Accredited self-assessment program

- 8 specific criteria need to be fulfilled
- Self-assessment programs developed or sponsored by NSS, faculties and colleges
 - includes MKSAP
- Training or virtual reality simulators used for the purposes of self-assessment (anaesthesia)
- 2 credits/hr - no maximum

4 Structured learning projects

- Learning activities are planned and the outcome is recorded and evaluated
- Personal learning projects generated from a clinical problem or participating in a CPD activity in another section
- Keeping a learning portfolio
- Traineeships, preceptored courses
- 1 credit/hr - no maximum

5 Practice Review and Appraisal

- Activities that assist specialist to review their practice
- Practice audits
- Institution audits, utilization studies
- Other care appraisal studies
(base on the practices of peers)
- 2 credits/hr - no maximum

6 Educational Development, Teaching & Research

- Activities that involve setting standards for practice
- Publication (writing, manuscript review)
- Preparation of presentations, lectures
- Research (e.g. grand proposals & clinical trials)
- Practice guideline development
- 1 credit/hr - maximum 100 credits

Individual Record Keeping
-but subject to possible audit

- Simple paper diary or computer record retained in office records for possible audit
- Record of attendance at CME days, accredited grand rounds, annual meetings, etc also retained
- Annual submission of simple electronic or machinereadable form
- 3% sample of fellows audited annually
 - asked to submit material
 - only audited in greater depth if necessary
