Thousands of therapy and imaging professionals in a variety of medical fields including radiology and oncology attend each year. Participants earn continuing education credit, exchange best practices with peers and review new equipment to inform future purchases for their clinics.

This year's theme is Connecting Our Pathways, Unifying Our Profession. AAPM will tie symposia, panel discussions, poster sessions and workshops on the latest medical physics topics to this overarching concept in an effort to help therapy and imaging physicists meet increasing demands.

Highlights for the 2017 AAPM Meeting include:

- **Medical Physics Leadership Academy Leadership Session**—Leadership Effectiveness experts will share methods to enhance and grow leadership skills focusing on networks and interactions to maximize performance and outcomes.
- **ePoster Discussions** — 585 presentations in the ePoster Theater and throughout the Exhibit Hall will promote lively discussion and scientific exchange.
- **The Presidential Symposium** — Leading physicians speak on integrating the three branches of medical physics: diagnostic imaging physics, nuclear medical physics and radiation oncology physics, into their practice.
- **Distinguished Lectureships** by Lihong Wang, Gene K. Beare Distinguished Professor of Biomedical Engineering at Washington University, St. Louis and Daniel Krewski, PhD, MHA, Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council of Canada Chair in Risk Science, Professor and Director, McLaughlin Centre for Population Health Risk Assessment, University of Ottawa.
- **3-Day Program on Ultrasound.**
- **Joint scientific symposium with the World Molecular Imaging Society – Imaging Hypoxia.**
- **Joint scientific symposium with ESTRO – AAPM Symposium: From Bench to Bedside via Veterinary Radiation Oncology.**
- **MR-in-RT mini-series**—A multi-part course on the role of MRI in radiation therapy, will offer comprehensive and focused education to both imaging and therapy physicists.
- **Educational Topic Specific Guided Tours** of technology presented by invited vendors.
- **SAMs**—With only a few exceptions, all invited sessions in the Education, Science, Professional, and Practical Tracks will offer SAMs.
